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This course is designed to expose students to practical applications of knowledge in their own and related fields, increase their knowledge of other disciplines, and create opportunities for them to experience a diverse range of social and cultural activities in the world outside university. The focus is on developing learning outside the classroom through encouraging student participation in guest lectures, conferences, and cultural events such as musical and theatrical performances, art exhibitions, literary readings, etc., both on campus and off campus. By providing students with exposure to professional, industrial, and socio-cultural realities, this course takes a first step towards preparing students for the changing world that will face them after graduation. And through this exposure, it aspires to give students a sense of respect for and pride in their own chosen profession, coupled with a feeling of responsibility to helping the community and working for the good of society. Assessment is based on the student's completion during the semester of a SPIKE Card, under the Honor Code, certifying participation in four socio-cultural, professional, or industry-related events sponsored by his or her own Faculty or School, and four events sponsored by other Faculties or Schools or organizations in the community.

This course includes the same requirements as GEED 101 and GEED 102, but has additional components: in addition to participating in four socio-cultural, professional, or industry-related events sponsored by his or her own Faculty or School, and four events sponsored by other Faculties or Schools or organizations in the community, each student is required to attend one other SPIKE event offered by any Faculty or School, and one SPIKE Certificate Seminar. SPIKE Certificate Seminars will be offered by the various Research Centers at the university. They take the form of 4-hour workshops, which will generally be held in the evenings and during weekends. They will include such topics as Leadership, Time Management, First Aid, and Environmental Activism. (One or more of these Certificate Seminars may be designated as compulsory.) In addition to completing their SPIKE requirement for this course, students will be awarded certificates for successful participation in the Certificate Seminars.

**GEED 101-102 Sosyokültürel, Profesyonel, Endüstriyel Bilgi ve Deneyim I - II**

Bu kurs öğrencileri hem kendi alanlarında hem de ilgili alanlarda pratik ve uygulamalı bilgilerle tanıştırmayı, öğrencilerin çeşitli disiplinler hakkında bilgilerini artırıp, üniversite dışındaki çeşitli sosyal ve kültürel aktivitelerle de deneyim kazanmaları için fırsatlar sunar. Bu kursun esas amacı, öğrencinin sınıf dışında öğrenme yeteneğini, kampüs ve kampüs dışındaki seminerlere, konferanslara ve kültür olaylarına (ör. Müzik ve tiyatro performansları, sanatsal sergiler ve edebiyat etkinlikleri) katılmalarını sağlayarak geliştirmektir. GEED 101 and GEED 102 will continue as last year, the only difference being the change to a 4-letter course code.

GEED 201-302, as described in the Senate-approved proposal for the establishment of the Department of General Education, have an additional 2 requirements. Originally, it was expected that each students would have to take 10 events—i.e. in addition to the 8 SPIKE events, 2 certificate seminars. Logistical considerations, however, giving our increasing student numbers, have made it necessary to have only one SPIKE certificate seminar, and have one additional normal SPIKE event, to be taken from any Faculty or School.

These courses continue to enrich students' experience of "Socio-cultural, Professional, and Industrial Knowledge and Experience," as part of their General Education background.
